

## **High Cost Services Allocation**

### **Overview**

High Cost Services allocations provide additional funds to local public school districts and other public schools that serve disabled students with extraordinarily high-cost needs. The allocations are funded with a total of \$8 million through two sources: (1) 50% with federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) funds, and (2) 50% state MFP funds. Without these allocations, schools find it extremely difficult to provide individualized supports and services necessary for these students to thrive in the education setting.
