Dear Representative Fannin:

Funds were provided in Act 7 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 2008 for major repairs for higher education facilities in the amount of \$75,000,000. The funds were distributed for projects on the higher education campuses as delineated in a formula by the Board of Regents for mission critical projects. Specific projects were then prescribed by the Board of Regents and approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. As projects are completed, unallocated funds are becoming available and there is a need to pursue additional major repair projects for the higher education facilities.

Facility Planning and Control requests approval to proceed with the implementation of one new project for the Louisiana State University System at the LSU Pennington Biomedical Research Center that has been identified and approved by the Board of Regents.

The scope of work for this project includes the repair of the existing security system for multiple buildings and parking areas on the Pennington campus. Funds in the amount of \$26,950.37 can be allocated from Act 7 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 2008 for this purpose. The source of funding will be any balance of funds remaining after allocation of previously approved projects. It is important to note that each campus' funds will remain with the campus to perform the additional project.

Act 25 of 2014 appropriated \$12,820,000 in General Obligation bonds to the Office of State Parks for the construction of vacation cabins in the Bayou Segnette State Park. Twelve (12) cabins were included in the base bld, and alternates provided for the construction of up to four (4) more, for a potential total of sixteen (16) cabins. Contract time was stated as 365 days, but made no provision for additional days for the construction of the alternates if awarded. FPC awarded the base bid plus all three alternates, for a total of sixteen (16) cabins.

The contractor has agreed to reduce the overall price of the contract by \$143,000 in consideration of 60 days additional construction time being added to the contract.

Therefore, Facility Planning and Control is requesting approval of a credit change order in the amount of \$143,000.

The land bridge was the only construction exit route from the site. The contractor could not haul off construction material from the site, nor remove heavy equipment. The work stoppage lasted 77 days until a temporary bridge was installed over the ravine to allow for the project to continue.

Change Order No. 2 is to pay the vendor, Weeks Marine, Inc. for stand-by time due to work stoppage caused by Chevron Gas pipeline that was blocking the designated project access route. Some of the barges, boats, dike construction equipment and personnel encountered a stand-by wait time of 11 days while waiting for access to the worksite. The equipment and personnel stand-by charges were \$8,608.46 per day.
