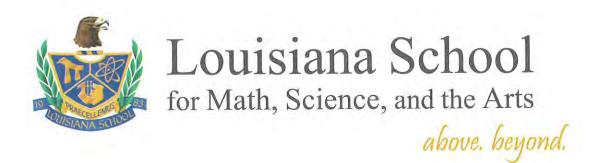

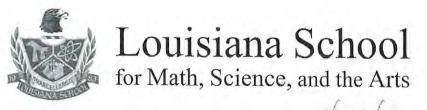

This letter serves as a formal request for the approval of a 10-day short bid for two 14-passenger school buses. We recognize that we are currently in the last month of the fiscal year and that the deadline for short bids is Wednesday, June 5, 2018.

The reason the procurement request was sent to OSP this late in the fiscal year was due to circumstances beyond our control as an agency. The funds being used to purchase these two buses are from the Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) through the Department of Education. The LDOE did not release these funds until mid-May and thus our agency didn't have the authority to expend the funds until May 28, 2018. This can be verified by the Office of Planning and Budget and our budget manager, John Burch. He can be reached at john.burch@la.gov.

The two buses currently in our fleet are 13 years old and have nearly 100,000 miles on each of them. The purchase of these buses has the full support of the LSMSA Board of Directors and the Louisiana Commissioner of Administration.

We fully understand that moving forward with the purchase may require the carrying forward of funds beyond the end of the fiscal year in order to fulfill a bona fide expense. We will work with OPB and OSP to ensure the timely purchasing of these buses throughout the next four or five weeks.

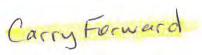

This BA-7 is in accordance with Title 39 - R.S. 39:82B - "The commissioner of administration may, with the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, incorporate into the new fiscal year's appropriation any appropriations from the prior fiscal year against which bona fide obligations existed on the last day of the fiscal year. No transactions shall be approved in this manner after the forty-fifth day following the last day of the fiscal year." The Department of Education, State Activities, (LDOE) is seeking to carryforward \$7,170,450 in State General Fund, in the District Support Program.

Due to unexpected adjustments to the schedule for assessment item development (Grades 3-HS), including the end-ofyear and progress monitoring assessments, it is necessary to move deliverables across administration, scoring, and reporting from one fiscal year to the next. For these reasons, the LDOE requests a carryover in the amount of \$6,115,580, (\$2,897,251 in State General Fund; and, \$443,624 in Title VI, \$985,211 in IDEA and \$1,789,494 in TIF Federal funds) for the Data Recognition Corporation (ELA/Math) contract (contract dates: October 1, 2016 - June 30, 2021). Further, the LDOE requests to carryover \$5,788,555 (\$4,273,199 in State General Fund; \$410,003 in Title VI and \$1,105,353 in IDEA Federal funds), for the Data Recognition Corporation (Administration - OTS companion) scoring, and reporting contract. These carryover funds are critical to the continuation of the required item development plan, close out of the previous year, and make resources available to educators for the beginning of the year (contract dates: July 1, 2016 - June 30, 2020). The adjustments to the schedule do not increase the overall cost of the deliverables of the contract. The total amount of this carryforward is \$11,904,135.

### **GENERAL PURPOSE**

This BA-7 is in accordance with Title 39 - R.S. 39:82B - "The commissioner of administration may, with the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, incorporate into the new fiscal year's appropriation any appropriations from the prior fiscal year against which bona fide obligations existed on the last day of the fiscal year. No transactions shall be approved in this manner after the forty-fifth day following the last day of the fiscal year." The Department of Education, State Activities, (LDOE) is seeking to carryforward \$7,170,450 in State General Fund, in the District Support Program.

Due to unexpected adjustments to the schedule for assessment item development (Grades 3-HS), including the end-of-year and progress monitoring assessments, it is necessary to move deliverables across administration, scoring, and reporting from one fiscal year to the next. For these reasons, the LDOE requests a carryover in the amount of \$6,115,581, (\$2,897,250 in State General Fund; and, \$443,624 in Title VI, \$985,211 in IDEA and \$1,789,494 in TIF Federal funds) for the Data Recognition Corporation (ELA/Math) contract (contract dates: October 1, 2016 - June 30, 2021). Further, the LDOE requests to carryover \$5,788,555 (\$4,273,199 in State General Fund; \$410,003 in Title VI and \$1,105,353 in IDEA Federal funds), for the Data Recognition Corporation (Administration - OTS companion) scoring, and reporting contract. These carryover funds are critical to the continuation of the required item development plan, close out of the previous year, and make resources available to educators for the beginning of the year (contract dates: July 1, 2016 - June 30, 2020). The adjustments to the schedule do not increase the overall cost of the deliverables of the contract. The total amount of this carryforward is \$11,904,135.

The amount requested represents 70% of the total savings which is deemed a bona fide obligation of the state. The remaining savings will be divided as follows:

20% - \$1,708,420 will be allocated to the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Criminal Justice to award competitive grants for various victim services.

30% - \$2,562,630 will be allocated to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to award incentive grants to parishes, judicial districts, and nonprofit community partner organizations to expand evidence-backed prison alternatives and reduce admissions to the state prison system.

50% - \$4,271,050 will be allocated to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections for targeted investments in reentry services, community supervision, educational and vocational programming, transitional work programs and contracts within parish jails and other local facilities that house state offenders to incentivize expansion of recidivism reduction programming and treatment services. In addition, we anticipate hiring up to 25 additional probation and parole agents to assist in field monitoring and new contract monitors who will assist in analyzing grants associated with Justice Reenvestment.

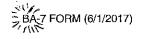
