- 130,053 homeowners have had their benefits calculated and of those, 130,053 (100%) homeowners have closed on their Road Home grant with disbursements totaling \$9,030,412,399. The average award is \$69,436.
- 119,173 (92%) of these homeowners have decided to stay and rebuild in Louisiana. Rebuilding resources provided to Option 1 homeowners totaling \$8,100,733,711. The average award is \$67,975.

- IMM funding has been provided to 25,730 homeowners totaling \$192,741,891.
- 95.6% of the 110,242 applicants monitored through this period have been dispositioned Compliant/Occupied.
- 32,388 applicants have received elevation disbursements totaling \$942,830,530.
